



2010 NCHA Super Stakes Stallion Subscription Rules

1. The 2010 National Cutting Horse Super Stakes will be held in the late spring.
2. Entries to the 2010 National Cutting Horse Super Stakes will be limited to foals of 2006, all breeds made eligible by the nomination of their sires to the list of subscribing stallions for this event. The 2010 Super Stakes Classic will be limited to foals of 2004 and 2005 with the same restrictions as stated above.
3. The added purse for the 2010 National Cutting Horse Super Stakes will consist of the total stallion subscription fees received less five percent (5%). An additional deduction of \$50,000, or twenty-five percent (25%) of the total added purse for the Super Stakes, whichever is less, shall be made to provide the added purse of the Super Stakes Classic. The remaining ninety-five percent (95%) after the deduction for the Super Stakes Classic purse is made will be divided between the Open and Non-Professional Super Stakes in direct proportion to the entries qualifying in each division. The Super Stakes Classic purse will be divided in a like manner.
4. Stallion subscription fees to make a stallion's 2006 foals eligible for the 2010 National Cutting Horse Super Stakes and a Stallion's 2004 and 2005 foals eligible for the Super Stakes Classic must be received no later than October 1, 2009 (No grace period).

FEE REPRESENTATION

The Nominator hereby represents and warrants to National Cutting Horse Association (NCHA) that the Nomination Fee listed hereon is the amount of the advertised stud fee for the 2005 breeding season for the stallion listed, or \$3,500, whichever is the greater amount. ***If such fee was not advertised or published, it must be equal to the prevailing stud fee established by the ranch, syndicate manager or owner for seasons sold to third parties during the 2005 breeding season, or \$3,500, whichever is the greater amount. In such case a copy of the 2005 stallion breeding report and all signed and validated breeding contract copies from the 2005 breeding season must be submitted along with this application to the NCHA by the prescribed deadline. All applicable breeding fee amounts paid, as indicated by the contracts, will be totaled and averaged (\$0- fees will not be taken into consideration) to establish the 2005 Market Value Breeding fee. This average will be used as the applicable stallion subscription fee for the 2010 NCHA Super Stakes program, provided such amount is equal to or in excess of \$3,500.*** The minimum Nomination Fee is \$3,500. For purposes of determining the advertised fee, only advertisements initiated by and paid by the syndicate manager or owner and published prior to or during the 2005 breeding season for which the stallion is nominated will be considered. In determining the Nomination Fee from advertisements which offer more than one fee arrangement, only the greater of the fees advertised will be accepted. **Copies of published advertisements stating breeding fees, arrangements or private treaty must be provided to the NCHA along with this form by the stallion nominator.**

For purposes of determining the established fee for breedings sold to third parties, the following will apply:

1. If 100% of the breedings from the ranch are sold on a no guarantee basis, then a Nomination Fee equivalent to the price of a no guarantee season will be acceptable.
2. If breedings are sold on both a live foal and no guarantee basis, then the Nomination Fee must be equivalent to the greater of the two.
3. If 100% of breedings are sold on a live foal basis or right of return, the Nomination Fee must be an amount equivalent to the price of a live foal or right of return season.
4. Any stallion bred to 10 mares or less in the year the eligible foals were conceived (2005) will pay the minimum fee of \$3,500, re-

gardless of the stud fee. A breeding report must be sent along with the completed nomination form.

Payment is made to NCHA in full on receipt of same by the stallion/syndicate manager or owner and no later than October 1, 2009 postmark deadline. **Nominator shall be liable for a delinquency or late charge at the rate of 5% per month on past due subscriptions starting October 2 until February 1, 2010. From February 2, 2010 until the time of the draw stallions can be subscribed for double the stallion fee or \$7,000 whichever is greater. Acceptance of payment by NCHA is not to be considered approval of nomination.**

A stallion may be subscribed for a particular future NCHA Super Stakes in order to guarantee his get's eligibility to be entered in that event. The fee for such subscription will be that normally due for the stallion on the date the event is held. There shall be no refunds or adjustments to the fee paid for any reason, and the fee will become a part of the added purse for the named event whether or not the stallion has issue nominated to the event.

5. Payment of fees: All subscription fees will be made payable to the National Cutting Horse Association in United States funds or its equivalent and transmitted by U.S. Mail showing a stamp cancellation date not later than midnight preceding the due date.
6. Declining Subscriptions: Subscriptions of stallions are received subject to the right of the appropriate National Cutting Horse Association committee to refuse the subscription and give notice to the subscriber by certified mail of said decision within ten days of the receipt thereof. The decisions of the committee shall be final in all matter.
- The National Cutting Horse Association reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the contest without liability to them, but in such event, shall return all stallion subscription fees to the subscribers.
7. Change of Ownership: A subscribed stallion may change ownership and remain eligible under the new owner provided the appropriate National Cutting Horse Association committee is so advised and the new owner acceptable.
8. Sire Award: The subscribers of the stallions siring the winners of the 2010 National Cutting Horse Super Stakes will receive five percent (5%) of the total stallion subscription fees, to be divided between the Open and Non-Professional divisions in direct proportion to the number of entries in each division.
9. There shall be no refunds or adjustments to the Subscription Fee paid for any reason. The Subscription fee will become part of the Added Purse for the 2010 Events whether or not the stallion has any foals nominated to the Events.
10. A list of all eligible stallions will be published in the earliest possible edition of Cutting Horse Chatter following the closing date of stallion subscriptions to the event, and will be available upon request directly from the National Cutting Horse Association.
11. All subscribers of stallions nominated to this event must be members in good standing of the National Cutting Horse Association.
12. These rules subject to change by action of the National Cutting Horse Association Executive Committee only.
