

The Horizon/NCHA Senior World Tour will be a year-long world tour played out at NCHA approved weekend shows during the 2015 point year. (Grassroots shows will not count).

The competitions will be a **class within a class** at any approved weekend show.

A Senior World Champion/Top 15 in all eligible classes will be crowned at the World Champions Award Banquet at the Futurity.

A senior contestant is defined as any open, non-pro, or amateur rider that is age 60 or older and meets all other NCHA rules regarding their status and membership.

Points will be accumulated to determine the Champion, Reserve Champion, and the next top 13 seniors in eligible classes.

POINTS EARNED AT THE WEENED LEVEL

in the following classes:

- 1. Open, \$15K Novice Horse, \$5K Novice Horse
 - The Open Top 15 Senior Rider will be those riders who accumulate the most points in the three open classes combined.
- 2. Non-Pro
- 3. \$15K Novice Non-Pro
- 4. \$5K Novice Non-Pro
- 5. \$50K Amateur
- 6. \$35K Non-Pro
- 7. \$15K Amateur
- 8. \$2K Rider/Any Horse

Standings will be determined by a point system that mirrors the mandatory payout. **Exception: A point will be given for 1-3 entries.** A point system is desirable over money's won as it allows the Affiliates/Producers to seek sponsorships for the senior class to enhance the classes, but does not give undue advantages over other Affiliates/Producers who may not have sponsors.

POINT SYSTEM—SAME AS MANDATORY PAYOUT— **See exception above for 1-3 entries**.

ENTRY FEE @ WEEKEND

- 1. Individual Affiliates/Producers will be allowed to determine the total entry fee for their senior class.
- 2. A Fixed Amount Award Fee will go to NCHA for World Finals Awards in the Senior Divisions—\$6.00
- 3. A minimum entry fee of \$20 will be required with \$10 jackpot, \$6.00/NCHA, \$4.00/Affiliates
- 4. A minimum of 50% of the entry fee would be jack-potted.
