10. Two Cow-Two-minute clock implemented in weekend classes \$35,000 Non-Pro, \$15,000 Amateur and \$2,000 Limit Rider.

WEEKEND SHOW COMMITTEE MISSION STATEMENT

1. Recommend rules and standards for the naming of NCHA circuit leaders and champions.
2. Recommend rules and standards to be used in qualifying for the NCHA affiliate, Circuit and National Championships, in addition to recommendations to purse, entry fees and the like.
3. Recommend rule changes to NCHA approved cutting horse contests not limited by age of horse.
4. Recommend the requirements for participation in the World Championship Finals.
5. Review the rules and procedures used in naming the Top Fifty Open Cutting Horses and Non-Professional Riders, as well as Top Fifty for other approved classes and makes recommendations to insure fair competition for these valued honors.
6. Work closely with World Championship Finals sponsors and/or possible sponsors to ensure the success of the event for all concerned.

STANDING RULE 6.j

j. All new shows applying for NCHA approval must offer both an open cutting horse contest and an unlimited class for Non-Professional riders with parity of added purses.

ITEM #6

NATIONAL CIRCUIT PROGRAM RULES 2023 POINT YEAR

ii. Exclusions

1. If a rider and/or horse competed in the 2023 NCHA World Finals, they are not eligible to compete at the National Circuit Championships in the same class(es) in which they competed in the 2023 NCHA World Finals.
2. Non-Pro riders that competed in the 2023 World Finals in the Non-Pro class may not compete in the Non-Pro class at the National Circuit Champions.
3. Any horse that finished in the top 15 of the 2023 NCHA World Finals standings in the Open class is ineligible to compete in any class except the JR/SR Youth.
4. Any horse show in the Open division of the 2023 NCHA World Finals is ineligible to complete in any class except JR/SR Youth
5. Any horse shown in the Non-Pro class at the 2023 NCHA World Finals is ineligible to complete in any class except JR/SR Youth.

NCHA EASTERN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

iii. Exclusions

iv. **Non Pro riders that competed in the 2022 World Finals in the Non-Pro may compete in the Non-Pro class at the National Championship provided they do so on a horse not shown in the Non-Pro World Finals.

Discuss the approval of championship shows with No Added Money

- Entry Fee capped at \$350
- This helps to protect the show producer - no expense of added money.
- 100% of entry fee is jack-potted and paid back to contestants.

Example:

Comparing a \$300 added class and a Jackpot Class - Non added
Based on a 9 horse class
