ITEMS FOR REVIEW AND REPORT

The Executive Committee issued a directive to the Weekend Show, Amateur and Affiliate Officers/Secretaries Committees to evaluate fees assessed at Challenger Shows now that the points have been determined by placing it on their convention agendas and report back to the EC at the August Meeting.

After much discussion and an effort to help clarify the calculation methodology, a MOTION was made by Barnwell Ramsey and SECONDED by John Lavelle to double the points for a championship show to maximize 20 from maximum of 10 and to leave the challenger show point scale maximum at 10 as shown below effective immediately. MOTION PASSED by majority with eight (8) in favor and four (4) opposed.

### **Anonymous Complaints**

A complaint can be submitted anonymously for Zero Tolerance and for Amateur/Non Pro status. The rule for <u>no anonymous</u> is related to other member to member and show complaints. Please review the rules below related to anonymous complaints as it is followed by a "no complaint" for competitive status or medication. You can submit information related to a violation to Julie Davis at <u>jdavis@nchacutting.com</u> Liaison, Non Pro Amateur Review Committee.

### Rulebook page 84-85

a. Filing a Complaint Any NCHA member may file a complaint regarding any alleged violation of NCHA Rules by submitting the complaint in writing to the NCHA Executive Director. The complaint must be signed by the person or persons filing the complaint or, if filed electronically, identify the name of the person or persons filing the complaint, and sent to the NCHA Executive Director together with a check or credit card payment in the amount of \$50 made payable to the National Cutting Horse Association. The complaint must be in essentially the form supplied by the NCHA and available on its website. The complaint must, at a minimum, contain the following information: the names of the person or persons filing the complaint, the name or names of the persons alleged to have violated the NCHA rules, the date of the alleged violation, the show at which the alleged violation occurred, the location on the show grounds where the alleged violation occurred, a detailed description of the activity that resulted in the alleged violation, and the names and addresses of all witnesses believed to have knowledge of the alleged violations There is no \$50 fee for filing a complaint about reporting a violation of the Zero Tolerance Policy or for a complaint submitted by an NCHA Director, a class representative, show management or a judge. Anonymous complaints will not be accepted, investigated, or acted on by the NCHA (except reports of

alleged violations and Zero Tolerance Policy that meet the requirements of Standing Rule 35.6). A complaint must be filed (postmarked, faxed, emailed or hand delivered) within seven (7) days of the alleged rule violation. The timing for filing a complaint alleging a violation of the Zero Tolerance Policy is contained in Standing Rule 35.6. No complaint is required for the NCHA to take disciplinary action regarding a member's competitive status (i.e., violation of Non-Professional and/or Amateur rules) or for violation of the NCHA medication and drug rules contained in Standing Rule 35A.

### Rulebook page 95-96

STANDING RULE 51.a.2.C. All Non-Professional and Amateur card holders will be reviewed at the time application is made. Said application to be on a form supplied by the Association and returned to it along with the applicant's annual dues. It is the member's responsibility to notify the NCHA office immediately upon any change in circumstances that may affect their Non-Pro/Amateur status. A Non-Professional and/or Amateur card may be reviewed or revoked at any time by the Executive Director, the Non-Pro/Amateur Review Committee, the Executive Committee or other committees appointed by the NCHA President in accordance with NCHA rules. However, the holder of a card so revoked shall have the right to appeal and a subsequent hearing before the Non-Professional/Amateur Review Committee. The burden of proof of eligibility shall be upon the applicant or card holder.

### Championship Shows - Rulebook page 35

### c. NCHA Unlimited Amateur Cutting Horse Class:

- 1) Open to qualified holders of NCHA Non-Pro Amateur cards who meet all non-monetary Amateur requirements, are qualified as an Amateur under Standing Rule 51 .a.6, are NOT in the Non-Pro Rider Hall of Fame AND are:
- a. Age 60 and over OR
- b. Under the age of 60 and have not won more than \$250,000 in Non-Promoney.

### Non-Pro money:

- a. Includes all earnings from Limited Age Event Non-Pro classes
- b. Includes all earnings from Championship show Non-Pro classes EXCEPT \$25,000 Novice Non-Pro, \$5,000 Novice Non-Pro and \$35,000 Non-Pro
- c. Does NOT include Challenger show earnings.

### \$250,000 Cap

### Limited Age Events – Rulebook page 99

**UNLIMITED** AMATEUR ~ Open to qualified Amateur contestants who are either:

- 1) Under the age of 60 and have lifetime Limited Age Non-Pro earnings (approved classes) of less than \$250,000. For purposes of this rule, Limited Age Non-Pro earnings will not reset at zero and will include qualified winnings in Limited Age Non-Pro competition in all (prior or future) approved Limited Age Event shows and monies won at shows with less than \$10,000 in added money, held in the 2015 point year or later, shall not count toward the \$250,000 cap. An Unlimited Amateur competitor who reaches \$250,000 or more in lifetime Non-Pro Limited Age event earnings can continue to compete in Limited Age Non-Pro classes until the beginning of the next point year. At that point, the Unlimited Amateur competitor must make a choice: to remain an Unlimited Amateur and compete exclusively as an Unlimited Amateur or to compete as a Non-Pro. At beginning of the next point year if the Unlimited Amateur competitor enters a Limited Age Non-Pro event and competes on any horse regardless of whether or not they win any money, they will forfeit their Unlimited Amateur status and can no longer compete in Amateur contests.
- 2) Aged 60 or Over Once an individual reaches the age of 60, if they qualify under Amateur rules, they may return to the Unlimited Amateur class, regardless of Limited Age Non-Pro class money won. The member will be allowed to show in both LAE Non-Pro and LAE Unlimited Amateur competition.

### \$250,000 Cap

### Leveling - Triple Crown

#### Amateurs with NON-PRO LAE EARNINGS CAP:

An Amateur competitor under the age of 60, who has won \$250,000 or more in total Non-Pro LAE money (excluding shows with less than \$10,000 in added money) MUST make a choice:

- to remain an Amateur and compete exclusively, during the current competition year in the Amateur Division OR
- · to compete in the Non-Pro Division

Intermediate Roll Back - Senior

Amateur riders aged 70 and older can roll back into the Intermediate level regardless of earnings, top 100 list rider rankings or Hall of Fame status.

### Top Tier Amateur Roll Back

Amateur qualified riders aged 60 and over may roll back into the top tier Amateur level regardless of Limited Age Non-Pro earnings.

#### Intermediate Roll Back - Top 100

Open or Non-Pro riders who are NOT listed on ANY of the Top 100\* money earning rider lists may roll back into their respective Intermediate levels.

Amateur riders who are NOT listed on ANY of the Top 100\* money earning rider lists AND are NOT in the Non-Pro Hall of Fame (if under age 60) may roll back into the Intermediate Amateur level.

\*Riders are placed on the Top 100 rider list(s) based on earnings in the respective division (Open, Non-Pro, Amateur) during the previous two (2) point years. The Open List reflects Open earnings, the Non-Pro list reflects Non-Pro earnings (except the weekend 25,000 and 5,000 Novice Horse Non-Pro classes), and the Amateur list reflects Amateur earnings.

The charts below are updated for all 2023 earnings at the end of the year.





#### Q8: Respondent would enter same number of Amateur Levels if they entered the Intermediate Non Pro








