

ANIMAL WELFARE

The Foundation supports the NCHA in its animal welfare programs with additional funding for drug testing at our competitions and better care of the cattle necessary to our sport. Additionally, we would like to support research projects at the collegiate level that fund and promote the welfare of horses and cattle. As funding is secured, the Foundation will participate in research projects that directly impact to our members.

Capturing the stories of the world's most impressive equine athletes, and those men, women and ranches which reflect who we are is our priority. YOUTH & SCHOLARSHIPS

The NCHA Foundation's goal is to provide a minimum of \$100,000 in annual scholarships to cutting horse youth members who are pursuing college educations and or accredited trade school educations. New guidelines for allocation of funding have been established to attract more scholarship applicants as well as to track their success and impact on the sport. An independent selection committee has been appointed to fairly and equitably award these monies to our deserving youth.
