## 2019 NCHA Rios of Mercedes World Championship Futurity UNLIMITED AMATEUR CUTTING HORSE CLASS



- 1.The NCHA World Championship Futurity Unlimited Amateur Cutting Horse class will be based on lifetime Limited Age Non-Pro earnings (approved classes) of less than \$100,000 (Limited Age Non-Pro earnings will not reset at zero for purposes of this rule), assuming Amateur criteria and eligibility requirements are met;
- a. Under the age of 60, the criteria necessary for remaining in the Unlimited Amateur class is lifetime Non-Pro Limited Age Event earnings (approved classes) of less than \$100,000. Beginning with the 2019 point year, an Amateur competitor who reaches \$100,000 or more in lifetime Non-Pro Limited Age event earnings can continue to compete in Limited Age Non-Pro classes until the beginning of the next point year. At that point, the Amateur competitor must make a choice: to remain an Amateur and compete exclusively as an Unlimited Amateur or to compete as a Non-Pro.
- b. Once an individual reaches the age of 60, if he or she qualifies under Amateur rules, they may return to the Unlimited Amateur class (LAE Events Only), regardless of Limited Age Non-Pro class money won. The member will be allowed to show in both LAE Non-Pro and LAE Unlimited Amateur competition.
- 2. 2019 NCHA World Championship Futurity Unlimited Amateur Cutting Horse contest will consist of one go-round. A Semi-Finals will be held if there are 100 or more entries at the time the last payment is due. Fifty percent (50%) plus ties will advance to the semi-finals based on go-round score. The maximum number of horses to advance to the semi-finals will be seventy-five (75) plus ties. The high scoring twenty (20%) percent from the go-round with a maximum of thirty (30) will advance to the finals based on the semi-finals score. If a semi-finals is not held, the high scoring twenty (20%) from the go-round with a maximum of thirty (30) plus ties will advance to the finals, a maximum of five (5) sets of cattle for the semi-finals and maximum two (2) sets of cattle for the finals regardless of the number of horses.In the event there are less than twenty-five (25) entries in a class, as of October 1, 2019, there will not be a working finals. Payout will be according to the NCHA mandatory payout. All finalists will receive premium checks.

Funding the PAC is important to be able to maintain state funding at the NCHA Triple Crown. Your contribution will provide critical assistance to the NCHA with this effort. To opt out of the PAC fee, submit your payment without the amount indicated as the PAC fee for your class.
- 5.Late entries or payments postmarked after the ten (10) day grace period will be subject to a penalty of 50% of the payment. Late entries will be accepted after the draw, but before the beginning of the first go-round by paying five (5) times the nomination fee, a total of \$8,230.
- 6.All rules of the 2019 NCHA World Championship Futurity will apply in this event where applicable.
- 7.By your signature on this entry form, you acknowledge that you are familiar with and subject to the provisions of the Medication and Drug Rules and Guidelines contained in the NCHA Rulebook. You also agree that, if requested, you will provide blood samples from your horse to comply with the random testing provisions contained in those Rules and Guidelines. Blood samples will be taken from the champion horses in all divisions. Random testing will also be performed throughout the show.
- 8. By your signature on this form, you agree and acknowledge that the NCHA's acceptance of any full or partial payments for any entry does not guaranty that the entry will be allowed to show at the Futurity. All entries must meet all requirements for the class or subclass in which that are entered to show in at the time that the competition occurs. In the event that the NCHA determines, in its sole discretion, that an entry is not qualified to show in any class or subclass in which it is entered at the time of the competition under NCHA rules, you agree that the NCHA can eliminate that entry with no further liability to the NCHA.
- 9. If entering under the Senior earnings eligibility rule, your date of birth must be provided below.
