Thank you for submitting a proposal to host an NCHA Circuit Championships show! The NCHA understands the following information is a proposal and not a complete plan of the event. Within 30 days of the start of the show, the selected host must re-submit this form with the complete and final details of the event.

The NCHA Circuit Championships is a finale show that celebrates the weekend cutter. If a circuit championships show is held in conjunction with a weekend or challenger show(s), NCHA does ask that emphasis be placed on the circuit championships aspect of the event. If a circuit championships show is held in conjunction with a weekend or challenger show(s), circuit championships qualifiers must be allowed to enter only the circuit championships class(es) for which he or she qualified. Each go round and working or non-working finals will receive separate show identification numbers. Hosts are encouraged to keep circuit championships classes on weekend days or as close to weekend days as possible. Placings, finalists, payouts awarded in the finals, and awards will be determined by score, or composite score in a non-working finals. Points will be awarded by the NCHA office. New for 2023, the circuit point year will continue until the second Sunday before Thanksgiving. The selected host will receive an \$8,000 subsidy: \$4,000 for added money and \$4,000 for production stipend.
